Southern Boundary is the Waikato /Taranaki territorial boundary from Mokau on the west coast across to (and including) Barryville. Then north east along SH30 to the left turn at Waipapa Road. North along this road to the Waipapa Dam and then following the Waikato river north to the roundabout at SH29 south of Cambridge. North from here to just north of Waharoa and into the kaimais to the Waikato / Bay of Plenty Boundary. Head north to the left of Paeroa , Turoa and Kopu to the firth of Thames

Then heading east along this boundary to the Waikato/ Hawkes Bay boundary east of Lake Taupō and following this north and then north east along the Bay of Plenty / Hawkes bay regional boundary to State Highway 2 between Waioveka and Matawai.
